On October 19, it will be two years since the Liberal government was elected on a promise to respect public service workers and strengthen our communities.

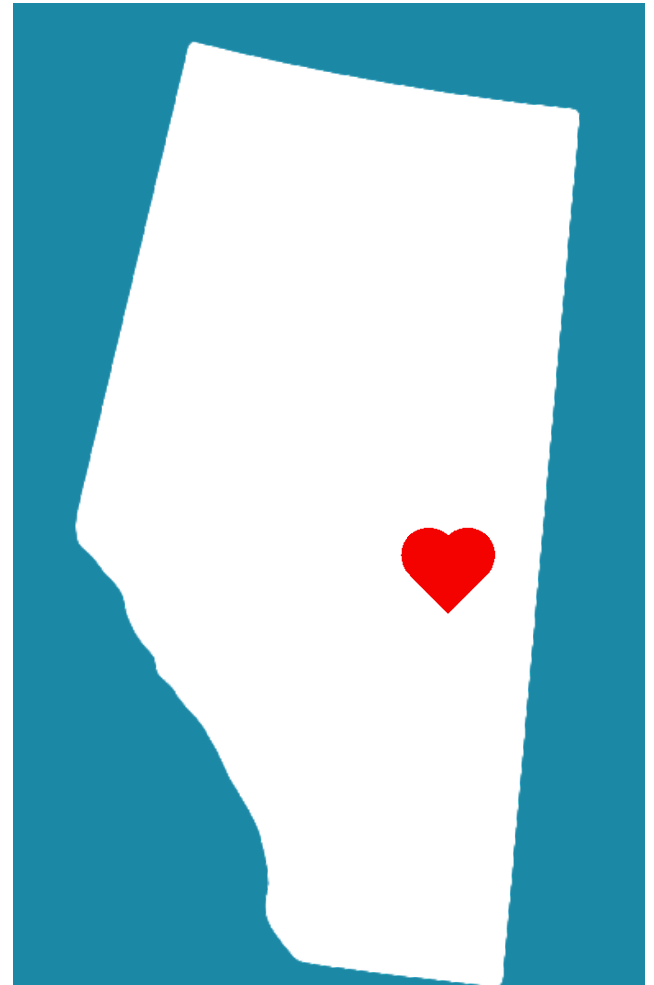
On that same day, public service workers at the CPC will have to make a terrible choice.

That's because the government plans to close the CPC in Vegreville and move the centre to Edmonton, forcing employees to relocate, commute three hours each day, or quit the jobs they love. With 250 workers—about five percent of the town's population—it has been one of the largest employers in Vegreville for 20 years.

This will cost taxpayers millions, and devastate a rural community already struggling in the current economic climate.
